Undefeated Jewell overpowers winless Culver-Stockton

Winless Culver-Stockton proved to be no match for undefeated William Jewell as the Cardinals scored 23 first-quarter points Saturday and rolled to a 58-12 rout in a Heart of America football game.

The Cardinals gained 432 yards behind a balanced offense. Seven players scored

touchdowns.

Jewell, 10-0 overall and 8-0 in conference, scored first on a safety when the Wildcats snapped the ball into the end zone. The Cardinals added to the lead, scoring first-quarter touchdowns on a 14-yard pass from Kelly Groom to Mike Phillips, a 3-yard run by Phillips and a 50-yard run by Vic Davoft. Wayne Landrum's 3-yard touchdown run in the second quarter increased the Cardinals' lead to 30-0 at halftime.
