Hudson Shines CARDINALS BEST DOANE 19-7

(Crete, Neb.) — Steve Hudson booted a 32-yard field goal on the last play of the first half giving William Jewell a 10-7 lead. The Cardinals went on to beat Doane College 19-7.

Cardinal linebacker Tim Johnson blocked a second

quarter punt giving Jewell a first down inside the Tiger 10 yard line. Quarterback Kelly Groom sneaked in from a yard three plays later and the Cardinals led 7-0.

On the ensuing kickoff, Doane's Maurice Kellogg bolted 92 yards to knot the score at seven.

Hudson gave the Cardinals all they needed on the al midway through the third quarter and Groom teamed with receiver Jimi Reed on a 27-yard pass play to set up the final Jewell score.

The Cardinals, ranked second in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics pre-season Division II football poll, move to 1-0. Doane falls to 1-1.

Crete, Neb.—With 4 seconds left in the first half, Steve Hudson kicked a 32-yard field goal, giving William Jewell a 10-7

halftime lead. The Cardinals went on to beat Doane College 19-7.

In the second quarter, Tim Johnson blocked a Doane punt and recovered the ball on the Doane 8-yard line. Three plays later, quarterback Kelly Groom sneaked in from the 1 for the Cardinals' first touchdown. Maurice Kellogg returned the following kickoff 92 yards, tying the game.

Hudson added another field goal in the third. In the fourth, Jan Redmond recovered a Doane fumble on the 28-yard line. Groom connected on a 27yard pass to Jimmy Reed, setting up another 1-yard run.

William Jewell rolled up 221 yards total offense. Scoop Gillespie led rushers with 19 carries for 79 yards. Groom was nine of 22 with one interception and 122 yards. Doane managed 80 yards on the ground.

Doane is 1-1 and the Cardinals are 1-0.
