William Jewell 55 Benedictine 25

Ninth-ranked William Jewell

used a strong running game and the passing of Scott Sandridge in a 55-25 non-conference victory over Benedictine in Liberty.

The Cardinals gained 315 of their 495 total yards on the ground. Steve Hodges was the leading rusher with 136 yards on 18 carries. Scoop Gillespie rushed 11 times for 113 yards and scored three touchdowns.

Sandridge completed nine of 16 attempts for 136 yards, including an 18-yard touchdown pass to Gillespie and a 13-yard scoring pass to Hodges.

The Cardinals, 7-1-1, jumped out to a 21-0 lead and never trailed.

Benedictine is 5-4.
