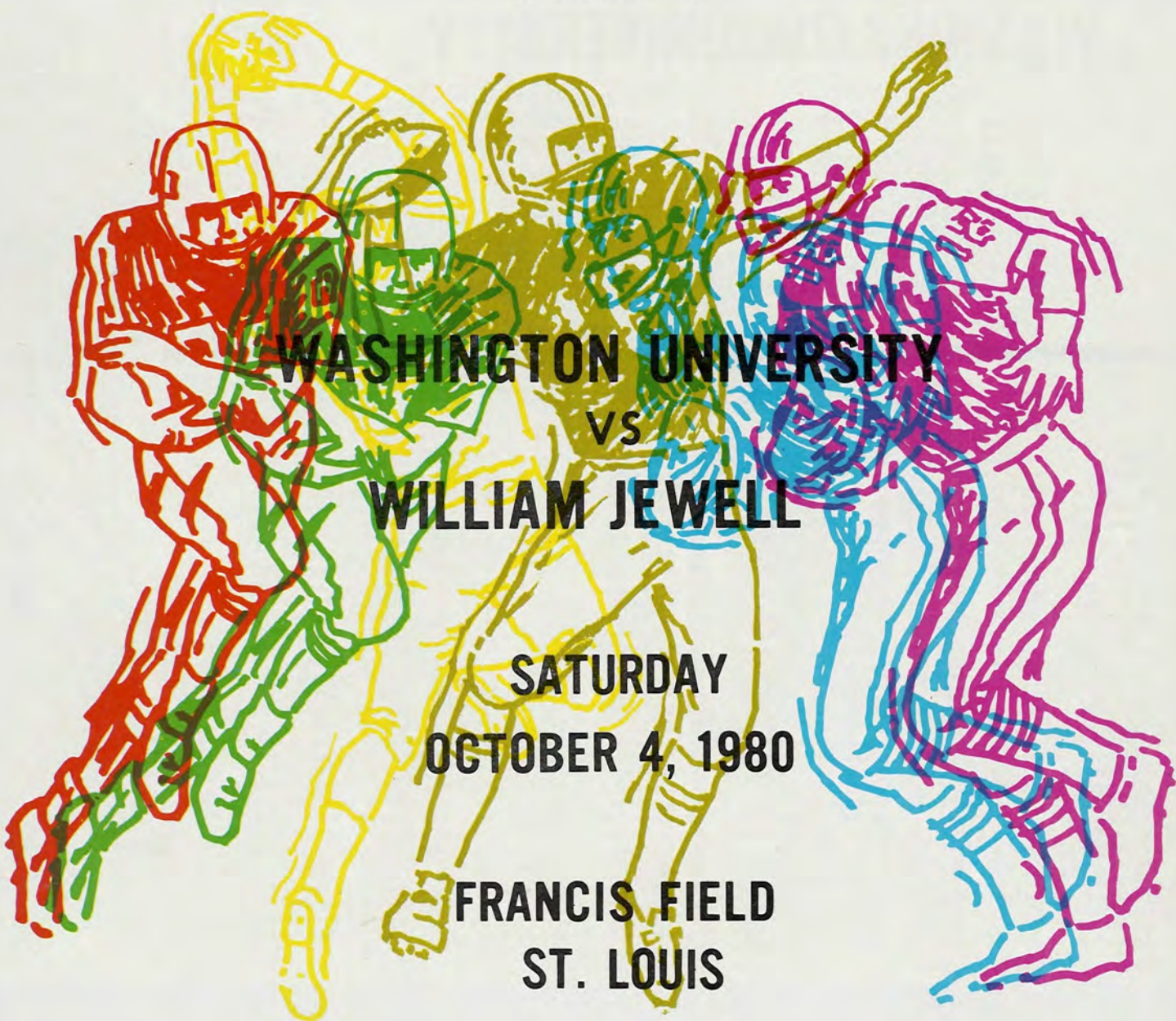

By being one of the most successful varsity teams at Washington University. The women's team last year compiled a 7-0 dual meet record, won the Division III State Championships, and won the Division III Regional Championships, a feat never matched by any other women's varsity team at Washington University. The men's team compiled a 5-4 dual meet record and were the St. Louis Area College Athletic Association (SLACAA) champions. Cumulative, both teams broke a total of twenty-two varsity records during the season.
