



CARDINAL REPORT

The Score: William Jewell 28
Doane College 3

BIG GAINS AND LOSSES: The Cardinal defense held Doane to minus 14 yards rushing on 38 carries. Defensive tackle Guy Weber led the Cardinals with three quarterback sacks and eight solo tackles. Redbird Quarterback Kelly Groom rushed for 102 yards on 12 carries. Scoop Gillespie scored three of the four Cardinal touchdowns. Doane entered the contest with a per game rushing total of 10 yards. Doane split end Curtis Shields may be out for the season following a third quarter ankle injury.

MISTAKES AND MISCUES: Doane fumbled eight times, losing five. Quarterback Groom tossed an interception with 30 seconds to go in the first half setting up Doane's only score: a 31-yard field goal.

QUOTE MARKS: Jewell defensive coordinator Dan Griggs forced a grin after hearing offensive game totals. "I think 28 total yards for the Doane offense says enough."

Quarterback Groom is hoping this week's open date gets the offensive machine rolling. "We need to sit back and get our act together."

NUMBERS GAME: The Cardinals have outscored their opponents 115-35. William Jewell has now come-from-behind in 12 of their last 17 contests, dating back to September of 1980, to win or earn a tie.

The Cardinals have now won four straight. Their last loss: December of '80 to Wilmington, Ohio 31-17 in NAIA post season play.

RECORDS: Jewell is 4-0. The Doane Tigers are 0-4. Last year's score, William Jewell 25, Doane 21.

ATTENDANCE: Saturday's attendance was 3500, boosting the season home total for two games to 7500.

IN THE HUDDLE: The Cardinals take this week off. Next action is October 10 versus Tarkio at Tarkio in a Heart of America Athletic Conference matchup. Kickoff set for 1:30 p.m.

EXTRA POINTS: Homecoming is scheduled for October 17. The Cardinals host Ottawa University. Kickoff set for 1:30 p.m.
