

Jewell To Football Playoffs In Texas

The William Jewell football Cardinals, under the direction of Head Coach Vic Wallace, will travel to Sherman, Texas, Dec. 5 to face Austin College in the semifinals of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics Division II football playoffs.

The Cardinals, who sport a perfect 11-0 record for 1981, defeated Pacific Lutheran University of Tacoma, Wash., by the score of 19-14 Nov. 21 in a quarterfinal contest. The Kangaroos of Austin College, with a record of 10-1, defeated Panhandle State University of Oklahoma in other quarterfinal action.

Beginning their trip to Sherman at approximately 6:30 a.m. on Thursday morning, the Cardinals will journey by bus to McCallister, Okla., where they will practice in the afternoon and stay that night. They are expected to arrive at Austin College early Friday afternoon. The team will be staying at the Rodeway Inn in Sherman.

There will be a pre-game banquet on Friday evening.

Game time is 1 p.m. Saturday. Ticket prices at the gate will be \$6 for general admission and \$7 for reserved seating. The gates will open at 11 a.m.

The other semifinal game has Westminster College of Pennsylvania hosting Concordia College of Minnesota. The final game is to be played on Dec. 12; the time and site for that contest is to be set Dec. 5 at the conclusion of the semifinals.
