Quakers defeat ¹³⁶ Jewell

LIBERTY, Mo. (AP) — Halfback Gary Worthy and fullback Russell Williams combined for 358 yards rushing and four touchdowns Saturday to lead the Wilmington, Ohio, Quakers to a 31-17 victory over William Jewell in NAIA Division II semifinal football action.

Wilmington will square off with Pacific Lutheran of California next week for the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics Division II championship.

Worthy, who rolled up 199 yards on 35 carries and ran for three touchdowns, was named the offensive player of the game. Williams rushed for 159 yards on 29 carries, including a 39-yard touchdown burst.

William Jewell, which held a 10-9 lead at halftime, managed only 11 yards on 21 rushing attempts. The Cardinals finished the season at 11-1-1, while Wilmington stands at 9-1.

William Jewell scored first, when quarterback Kelly Groom hit tight end Scott Martin with a 10-yard touchdown strike late in the first quarter.
