RED RAGE RIPS TARKIO - MAKES THE PLAYOFFS

The William Jewell Cardinals rushed past the Tarkio Owls 41-0 in Tarkio last Saturday night to finish the regular season at 8-1-1. The Cardinals tied for second in the Heart of America Conference at 5-1-1 with Missouri Valley, behind Baker who finished at 7-0.

The Cardinals rolled up 554 total yards and were led by senior running backs STEVE HODGES (10-105) and SCOOP GILLESPIE (9-99). Tarkio had 116 yards passing and only 2 yards rushing. The game was played in a cold drizzle and partial snow on a very slippery and muddy field at Tarkio. The Red Rage intercepted seven Tarkio passes and kept the Owls in poor field position, dominating the game. Scoring summary went like this:
