

William Jewell is playoff bound

The William Jewell Cardinals, nationally ranked seventh in the NAIA Division II, shut out the Tarkio Owls 41-0 on Saturday, Nov. 12, qualifying them for post-season play.

Jewell began its scoring binge in the first quarter when senior quarterback Scott Sandridge ran a bootleg 19 yards for a touchdown at 10:54 in the first quarter of play.

Sophomore kicker Dave Riley kicked a 27-yard field goal with :35 left in the quarter for a 9-0 lead.

Senior running back Steve Hodges ran in an 8-yard score at 11:27 in the second quarter, but the 2-point run attempt on the conversion failed.

At 6:28 in the second period, Hodges tossed a 42-

yard touchdown pass to senior wide receiver Jimi Reed on a half-back option pass. The score was sent up by an interception by senior free safety Mike Newman.

Senior cornerback Brian Fairchild's interception at 5:01 in the second period started a drive that ended with a 9-yard touchdown run by senior quarterback Paul Troth. The 2-point pass from Troth to senior tight end Jeff Gourley (Liberty, Mo.) was good for a 31-0 Jewell lead.

Senior running back Fernders Gillespie ran 60 yards for a touchdown at 12:59 in the third quarter and Riley added the point-after for a 38-0 score. Riley kicked his second field goal of the night to complete

scoring with a 39-yard boot with 3:28 left in the third quarter.

Jewell ran up 554 total yards against the Owl defense.
