

William Jewell takes 10-0 record to playoffs

A day after completing an unbeaten regular season with a 58-12 rout of winless Culver Stockton, the William Jewell Cardinals learned they will face Pacific Lutheran University this Saturday in the first round of the NAIA Division II playoffs.

Pacific Lutheran will bring a 9-0 record against Jewell's 10-0. The Tacoma, Wash., school is on a 14-game winning streak and the defending Division II national champion.

William Jewell had no trouble disposing of Culver-Stockton. The Cardinals gained 432 yards, with seven players scoring touchdowns.

The Cardinals scored first on a safety, then added first-quarter touchdowns on a 14-yard pass from Kelly Groom to Mike Phillips, a 3-yard run by Phillips and a 50-yard gallop by Vic Davoltg. Wayne Landrum's 3-yard touchdown run in the second quarter increased Jewell's lead to 30-0 at halftime.

Elsewhere in Missouri college football Saturday, MissouriRolla

slipped past Northeast Missouri 17-16, Central Missouri downed Southeast Missouri 31-11, Central Methodist outlasted Tarkio 50-32, Pittsburgh State upended Missouri Western 25-6, Missouri Southern downed Wayne State 23-19, and Southwest Missouri blasted Lincoln 47-7.

Craig Thomas kicked a 25-yard field goal with 4:22 left to boost Rolla past Northeast Missouri. Northdeat dominated the game early, scoring on a 25-yard field goal by Dave Austinson and a 68-yard pass play from Tom Hayes to Greg Hampton. The Bulldogs extended their lead to 13-0 with a 19-yard Austinson field goal in the third period, but Rolla took the lead with two touchdowns in the third quarter. Northeast Missouri, which clinched the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association title finished 4-1 and 6-4.
