

What a great win for our guys last Saturday. It was super to see all of the William Jewell fans at the game cheering for their team.

Our guys came out of last weeks game healthy and that is a good sign. We controlled the game on offense and recorded our first shut out of the season. Statistically, we had 203 yards rushing and 197 yards passing while Central Methodist was held to just half of that.

We had six different men scoring six touchdowns and 8 different pass receivers. In addition, we had eight backs carrying the ball effectively. Coach Wallace feels secure in sending anyone into the game in crucial situations.

Our scoring went this way. In the first quarter, Steve Hodges (sophomore) scored on a 2-yard run. Jerry Burch (sophomore) kicked the PAT. Then, Scoop Gillespie (sophomore) ran for 37 yards and another score. Burch again made the conversion. Then, Burch added a 25-yard field goal for the only score of the second quarter.

In the third stanza, Kelly Groom (junior) passed to Mike McGill (senior) for 12 yards and a TD. Minutes later, Groom threw a strike to Marty Hensley (senior) for a 19 yarder and another six points. Steve Hudson (junior) added a PAT. In the fourth quarter, Andre Nelson (sophomore) ran 15 yards on a super effort for six points. Wayne Landrum (junior) added insurance with a 1-yard run. Hudson added two more conversions and it was 44-0.

Kelly had a great game. He had 12 completions on 16 attempts, good for 162 yards, with no interceptions. He called a great game and his leadership again was instrumental in the game. Scoop Gillespie was our leading rusher with 76 yards on 14 carries while Mike McGill was our leading receiver with 82 yards on 5 catches.
