Cards Pummel Pioneers

First-year coach Vic Wallace has one William Jewell football victory under his belt and he's not about to stop there. "I'm excited about our first win," smiled Wallace following Saturday's 31-7 thumping of Mid-America Nazarene of Olathe, Kan.

"It feels great to win and I'm excited about this week of practice," he added. "We'll have to cut down on the turnovers."

The Cardinals fumbled four times and gave up four interceptions, but Mid-America could never get their offense rolling. Freshman linebacker Tim Johnson, starting in his first game as a Cardinal, collected 13 solo tackles and added eight assists. "I'd have to say I played a pretty physical contest," Johnson grinned. "But then, the entire defense and offense worked hard."

The Cardinals scored midway through the first period when sophomore "Scoop" Gillespie found daylight and scampered 87 yards to paydirt. Minutes later quarterback Kelly Groom directed a scoring drive that ended in a 24-yard Jerry Burch field goal.

"Our offense was a little shaky at times," Groom said. "It was also great at times. However, I think it will get much better after another week of practice."

Groom found tight end Scott Martin over the middle early in the second half for a 47-yard scoring strike.

Mid-America put its seven points on the

board when Ken Jolly picked off an errant Groom pass and sprinted 55 yards. The Pioneers managed only 74 yards of total offense.

"The defense did an outstanding job," Wallace echoed. "I was pleased with their overall performance. We've still got some things to iron out."

The Redbirds added two fourth quarter touchdowns. A halfback pass from Randy Doyle to Mike McGill put the Cardinals on top 24-7, before Andre Nelson led a late scoring drive to account for the 24 point margin.

The Cardinals travel to Lamoni, Ia. this Saturday for an afternoon Heart of America Athletic Conference meeting with Graceland. Graceland shut down Grinnell 37-0 in their season opener.
