Jewell, moving to $9-0$ and ranked second in the NALA Division II poll, relied on a gutsy flea-flicker to set up a go-ahead touchdown with seconds remaining in the first half. "It was a well-executed play," Cardinal
quarterback Kelly Groom said. "Tm just thankful Mike McGill was open downfield after it was all over:"

Baker, 7-2 and ranked number 11 in NAIA Division II, dominated the entire first half, but appeared confused following the 42 yard gain.

The Cardinals trailed $10-7$ with $19 \mathrm{sec}-$ onds to go in the first half. They faced a third down and 23 from just inside the midfield stripe.

Groom took the snap from center, and handed off to flanker Marty Hensley behind the line of scrimmage. Hensley handed off
to "Scoop" Gillespie just behind center and Gillespie optioned back to Groom. Groom set up, looked downfietd and found Mike McGill for a 42 -yard gain.
