

Cardinals' Cunningham ready

LIBERTY (AP) — William Jewell's star fullback, David Cunningham, is expected to be back in action Saturday when the Liberty school hosts Baker University in a National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics playoff game.

Cunningham has been sidelined since he received an ankle injury more than three weeks ago in the early action of a 55-11 drubbing of Missouri Valley College in Marshall and was kept on the sidelines when Baker and Jewell battled to a 10-10 tie in

their Heart of America Athletic Conference skirmish, also here. Cunningham additionally did not play in the Cardinals' regular season finale at Canton when Culver-Stockton College's Wildcats were routed 56 to 6.

Jewell is 10-0-1, while Baker holds a 9-0-1 record. The two teams are ranked second and third, respectively in the NAIA's Division II.

Cunningham is Jewell's leading rusher with 1,400 yards in eight games.
